Answer:

- **Fonts:**
 - **Type and Size:** Determined by eBook reading application or device.
 - **Colors and background colors can be adjusted:** Determined by eBook reading application or device.
- **Background: High contrast color settings are available:** Determined by eBook reading application or device.
- **Text-to-speech tools:** EPUB provides text-to-speech support.
- **All images have alt tags:** EPUBs have alt tags.
- **All videos are captioned:** Not applicable.
- **Text, image tags, and captioning sent to refreshable Braille displays:** The reflowable EPUB 3.3 files work with screen readers and refreshable Braille displays when opened in compatible eBook reading applications.

The Land of Hope textbook and Teacher's Guide are provided as a reflowable EPUB 3.3 digital file, the latest W3C Recommendation, conforming to EPUB Accessibility 1.1 and WCAG 2.2 Level AA. The EPUBs support accessibility features including screen reader compatibility, text-to-speech support, alternative text for images, and semantic tagging for a reflowable EPUB format. Presentation features such as font selection, color themes, high-contrast modes, user-adjustable font sizes, display settings, and compatibility with refreshable Braille displays are determined by the eBook reading application or device.

2. How are the following navigation features provided in the instructional materials:

Answer:

- **Non-text navigation elements (buttons, icons, etc.) can be adjusted in size:** Determined by eBook reading application or device.
- **All navigation elements and menu items have keyboard shortcuts:** Determined by eBook reading application or device.
